Teaching responsibilities include three (3) sections of Upper School Spanish: Spanish I, Spanish III and Spanish III Honors. This is a maternity leave coverage position and will run from January 15th through June 15, 2022.

Lincoln School values working with a diverse faculty and staff and seeks applications from individuals who share our commitment to educating girls to fearlessly embrace the opportunities and responsibilities of full citizenship in a complex world. Teachers at Lincoln maintain a reflective practice that involves collaboration and critical dialogue with colleagues and division leadership about their teaching; they embrace and uphold Lincoln's values of diversity, equity and inclusion; and they bring anti-racist practices into their classroom.

The ideal candidate will have at least three (3) years of teaching experience and must be comfortable working with Spanish students at a range of skill levels. The successful candidate will also be an active member of the World Language Department team, and will have experience with student-centered teaching and the confidence and skills to meet the needs of a variety of learners in the Upper School grades. A commitment to an all-girls environment, and the desire to inspire and engage young women in all four language skills (reading, writing, speaking and listening) and cultural exploration are essential. An advanced degree is preferred, though not required.
