### Lincoln School's STEAM Hub for Girls Grand Opening May 3, 2018—6 p.m.

Providence, RI (May 1, 2018) — Lincoln School's new STEAM Hub for Girls, a \$5M addition to the Blackstone Boulevard side of the historic building, is officially opening on Thursday, May 3 at 6 p.m. You're invited to the Grand Opening Celebration to see the innovative architecture up close, explore the state-of-art teaching space, and hear from Head of School Suzanne Fogarty and Board Chair Martha Boss Bennett '85 about all that Lincoln does to shift the gender balance of women entering STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts/Architecture, and Math) fields.

The STEAM Hub, the only dedicated space for STEAM learning for girls in Rhode Island, features a modern 2-story glass facade, 4,000-square-foot of interdisciplinary learning space including new physics and chemistry labs and recently renovated biology labs, glass-enclosed study spaces, and an art gallery for students and visiting artists. Several examples of students' innovative STEAM projects from across grade levels will be on display, showcasing education in action.

The stunning addition was designed by LLB Architects of Pawtucket, a visual expression of Lincoln's mantra "where tradition meets innovation," and built and managed by Shawmut Design and Construction of Providence.
